

Disposal Area

The City operates a transfer station, recycling center and leaf compost area for use by City residents. A permanent vehicle identification sticker is available for all bona fide residents at the City Clerk's Office. This sticker permits access to both the transfer station and recycling areas.

The Disposal Area is open to residents Monday through Friday from 7:30 a.m. to 3:45 p.m. and from 7:30 a.m. to 4:45 p.m. on Saturdays.

Items that may be disposed of include appliances, clothes, lumber up to 6 feet in length, metal cans, rugs, general refuse, furniture and mattresses. Leaves may be brought for composting, but no hazardous waste is accepted. Don't forget to get a sticker!

Garbage Pickup

The City collects household garbage once weekly, up to a maximum of (4) 20-gallon cans per unit. The collection day varies based on where you live.

Garbage is collected from the rear of the house. Just keep the cans covered and in the same location each week, and provide a clear path for the crew to collect them. Cans must not be placed at the curb. Call (908) 273-6404 to determine your collection day.

Garbage cans must be watertight metal or plastic cans with tight-fitting lids, and must not weigh more than 75 pounds each.

Recycling

The City has a recycling program every 2 weeks for newspapers, batteries, aluminum, metal, glass, plastic, magazines and corrugated cardboard. These are collected at the curb separately from garbage.

Please keep newspapers separate, either in brown paper bags or tied with string (not tape or wire). Rinse out all bottles and cans and place them mixed together in a sturdy reusable container.

We also collect magazines and corrugated cardboard, which should be tied both ways with twine.

The bags and containers must not be placed at the curb prior to the night before the scheduled pickup.

Dial-a-Truck

Bulky waste items are those too large to fit into a trash can or into a passenger vehicle to be taken to the Transfer Station. These very large items are picked up at curbside twice each month by appointment only. This is a service for residents only.

You must register first for a pickup by calling the Department of Community Services at (908) 273-6404, including a detailed list of items to be collected. Only those items on the list will be picked up.

Items for Dial-a-Truck collection must be placed out at curbside, but no earlier than the evening prior to the scheduled pickup. Tenants vacating apartments must not leave items at curbside prior to leaving. Construction debris from renovation projects and business trash are not collected.
