Affordable Housing Committee Meeting
Thursday, February 27, 2020, 6:30 pm
City Hall – Janet Whitman Conference Room**

Paul Cascais, DCS Director, opened the meeting at 6:35pm. He invited the group to introduce themselves.

The DCS Director reviewed the 2020 Status Report and answered any questions the group had about the updates listed in the report.

Joseph Billy, Administrative Agent, provided the attendees with his update report including but not limited to unit rehabilitation progress, the qualifying of several AH units/tenants and the status of the sewer main replacement at the Chestnut Street housing site.

The current balance of the affordable housing trust account (\$2,412,642.79) was shared and noted that it still includes the council approved payment for the Habitat for Humanity project (\$1.2M) and the \$400k rehabilitation amount.

The attendees (AH committee members and public) were invited to and took part in an open discussion on affordable housing.

The next AH Committee meeting is scheduled for October 8th, 2020.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:35pm.
