Residents to Renew Annual Parking and Transfer Station Permits by October 31

SUMMIT, N.J., October 6, 2025 – The City of Summit Parking Services Agency is sharing information on renewing resident parking permits. All current valid Summit resident parking permits expire on October 31, 2025. [Online registration](#) is now open; new permits will be valid from November 1, 2025, through October 31, 2026.

Permits are required by the City of Summit for residents to park in long-term municipal parking lots and garages and to use the Municipal Transfer Station on 40 New Providence Ave.

Registered permit holders with an existing online account may renew a permit online at cityofsummit.org/permitrenewal. Step-by-step instructions are available in the “Help” section of the online portal.
