February 2022 Blotter

2/03/2022—At 0938 hours a report was taken for a theft from a Hillcrest Avenue residence. The victim stated the incident occurred on 2/2/22 at approximately 1830 hours. Camera security footage captured a black male wearing dark clothing and a face mask approach the victim's front porch and take a delivered package. The total amount of the theft was \$200.

2/04/2022—Gerald Marshall, 27, of Summit was arrested and charged with criminal trespass and theft of credit cards. Mr. Marshall was processed and released with a pending court date.

2/06/2022—At approximately 1743 hours a report was taken for an attempted theft of a motor vehicle located at a Canoe Brook Parkway residence. A doorbell camera captured a black male wearing a puffy black jacket, dark pants and white sneakers enter an unlocked 2022 BMX X5. No key fob was in the vehicle. Unable to start the vehicle, the actor ran down the driveway towards the street and fled in a dark colored sedan. Nothing was reported as taken from the vehicle.

2/14/2022—At 1950 hours a report was taken for a motor vehicle theft located at a Chapel Street residence. The victim stated that they left their vehicle unsecured to go inside the residence for 10 minutes. On exiting the residence, they noticed that the vehicle was missing.
