March 2022 Blotter

3/02/2022—At 2021 hours a report was taken for a theft from a Whittredge Road residence. The victim stated multiple packages that were delivered to the residence were taken from the front porch between 1600 hours and 1830 hours. The total amount of the theft was not provided at the time of the report.

3/05/2022—At 0616 hours a report was taken for a theft from an unlocked motor vehicle located at a Morris Avenue business parking lot. The victim stated the incident occurred between 1730 hours on 3/4/22 and 0530 hours on 3/5/22. Taken was a black Lenovo laptop valued at \$800.
