Summit Police Department Responds to Armed Robbery at Morris Turnpike Sunoco Station

SUMMIT, NJ, August 22, 2022 – On Sunday, August 21, 2022, at approximately 6PM Summit Police Department responded to a report of an armed robbery at Arch Sunoco on Morris Turnpike in Summit, NJ.

Two male suspects wearing hoodies and face masks driving a black, four-door Audi with a temporary license tag in the rear window entered the Sunoco service station and parked adjacent to the fuel pumps. The driver exited the vehicle with a shotgun, approached the attendant in the cashier's booth and demanded money. The second suspect, armed with a handgun, searched the attendant, and removed \$95 in cash from their person.

The suspects returned to their vehicle and fled east on Morris Turnpike towards Springfield, NJ. The gas station attendant was unharmed.
