### **Summit Police Department Respond to Report of an Unconscious Man at Bus Stop**

SUMMIT, NJ, August 12, 2022– Summit Police Department responded to a report of an unconscious man at a bus stop outside the Summit train station at approximately 2:50AM on Friday, August 12, 2022.

When officers arrived at the scene, they found an unresponsive male lying on a bench. Officers immediately began life saving measures, administering CPR and Narcan. The victim, a 35-year-old Summit resident, was pronounced dead at the scene. Summit Police were assisted at the scene by the Summit Volunteer First Aid Squad and Atlantic Health System paramedics.

The official cause of the death of the victim is undetermined pending an autopsy but the Union County Medical Examiner's Office. According to police, foul play does not seem to be a factor. The incident is under investigation by the Summit Police Department Detective Bureau.
