Residents to Renew Annual Parking and Transfer Station Permits by November 15

SUMMIT, N.J., October 12, 2021 – Effective now through November 15, Summit residents are required to renew annual parking and Transfer Station permits online. Permits are required by the City of Summit for residents to park in municipal parking lots and garages and to use Municipal Transfer Station on 40 New Providence Ave.

The deadline to renew annual permits has been extended from November 1 to November 15, 2021. New permits will be valid from November 1, 2021, through October 31, 2022.

To begin the renewal process, all registered permit holders will receive an email by Monday, October 18 with instructions and a link to the permit system webpage. Registered permit holders with an existing online account may renew a permit online at <https://summit.gtechna.net/permit-portal/login.xhtml>.
