Weekly blotter December 5 to December 11, 2022

12/8/2022—At approximately 1920 hours a burglary occurred at a Wentworth Road residence. The residence was unoccupied at the time of the incident. Forced entry was gained to the home by opening a basement window. At the time of the report the victim was unable to provide a list of items stolen or the values.
