Summit Foundation Awards 85K Grant to City for Mabie Playground Project

SUMMIT, NJ, March 1, 2024 – In December 2023 the Summit Foundation awarded the City of Summit an \$85,000 grant for the Mabie Playground Transformation Project. The grant will help to fund the creation of the city's first inter-generational park and fully ADA accessible and sensory-friendly play space on the Village Green.
