Summit Fire Department Responds to Fire at Irving Place Residence

SUMMIT, N.J., October 12, 2024 – On Saturday, October 12, at approximately 4:33 PM, Summit Fire Department was dispatched for a report of smoke in the basement of a multi-family residence on Irving Place. Summit Police Officers on scene reported an active fire in the basement of the home; Summit Fire Department arrived on scene at 4:37 PM.

Mutual aid was provided by on scene by Millburn, Springfield, Union, Hillside fire departments; as well as Summit Police and the Summit Volunteer First Aid Squad. Searches of the floors of the residence were conducted, confirming reports that all residents were safely evacuated from the home. The fire was declared under control at 5:05 PM.

Members from the Summit Building Department, Union County Fire Investigation Unit and the Red Cross were on scene to assist. Additional building coverage was provided by New Providence, Westfield, and Plainfield fire departments. There were no reported injuries to first responders or residents.
