Donate to the Tatlock Playground Project

SUMMIT, NJ, May 23, 2025 – The Summit Department of Community Programs (DCP) is launching a fundraising drive to raise money for the Tatlock Playground project. Residents and business owners are invited to make a donation or sponsor a play structure and have their name inscribed on a plaque recognizing their donation.

\$750,000 has been funded by the 2024 and 2025 municipal capital budgets and the department has received \$102,000 from the NJ Local Recreation Improvement Grant and the Union County Kids Recreation Trust Fund Grant. There is still \$400,000 remaining needed to reach the fundraising goal of \$1.3 million.

“We are excited about the future of Tatlock Playground and eager to see community members enjoy the space once the project is complete,” says DCP Director Mark Ozoroski. “We hope you will consider making a donation, purchasing a bench, or sponsoring a play structure to help us complete this important project.”

Sponsorship opportunities are available for six different play structures and five benches, and individuals can also choose between four different levels of giving for the Owl Hall of Fame. Potential playground designs are available to view [online](#); the final design will be dependent on fundraising by the August 1, 2025, deadline.
