06/16/2025—A 30-year-old male from Newark was arrested and charged with three (3) counts of motor vehicle theft, one (1) count of receiving stolen property, and one (1) count of conspiracy to commit motor vehicle theft. 06/20/2025—At 1835 hours a report was taken for a theft that occurred at a Glenwood Place residence. The victim stated that a delivered Amazon package was stolen from her doorstep sometime during the day. Taken was a Koosa Bug Zapper, valued at \$50.00.

06/21/2025—At approximately 0040 hours, officers from the Patrol Bureau conducted a motor vehicle stop on Morris Avenue at Summit Avenue for violation 39:4-88, Failure to Maintain Lane, and 39:4-81, Failure to Observe Traffic Control Device. Following an on-scene investigation, the 29-year-old male driver from Keyport was subsequently arrested and charged with driving while intoxicated. The defendant was processed and released with a pending municipal court date.

06/24/2025—A 48-year-old male from Newark was arrested and charged with shoplifting from a Deforest Avenue business. Two (2) bottles of TheraFlu and four (4) bottles of Tylenol were taken, valued at a total of \$71.49. The defendant was processed and transported to Union County Jail.
