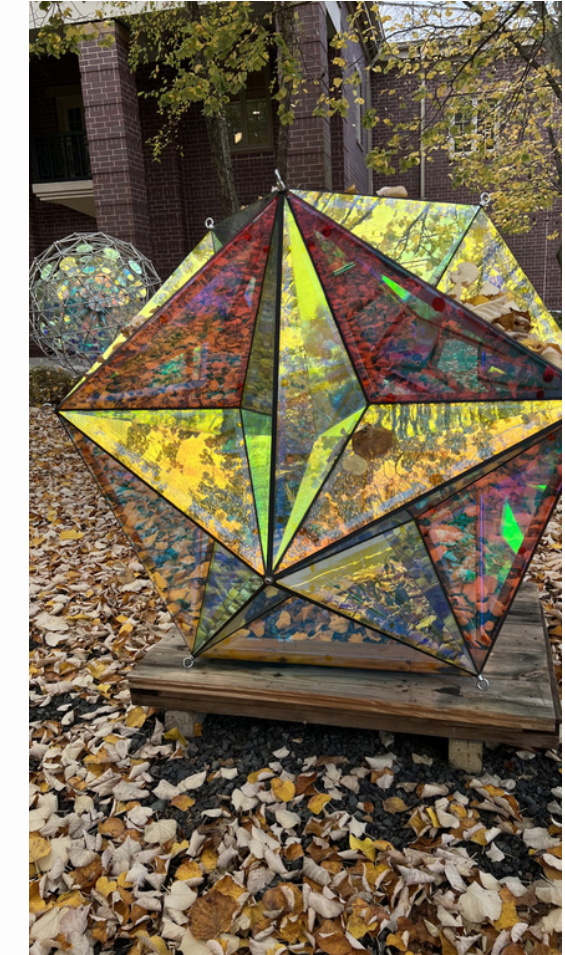

## MISSION

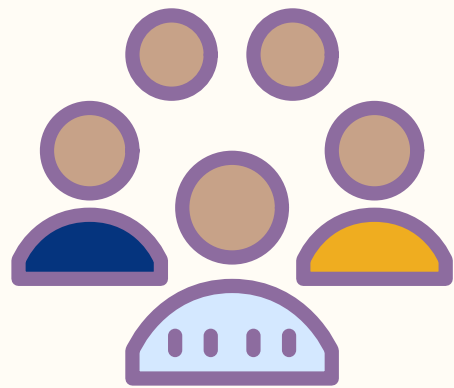
The City Clerk serves as the secretary to the municipal corporation and governing body. The office administers local elections and provides a number of administrative and community relations services. As secretary to the governing body, the City Clerk coordinates and attends all Common Council meetings, prepares agendas and minutes and a majority of the ordinances and resolutions, and maintains official city files and records. The office is the keeper of the official city seal. The City Clerk receives, distributes and assigns all correspondence on behalf of the Mayor and Common Council.

ROLE	RELATIONSHIP	RESPONSIBILITIES
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• General liaison to all city volunteer boards.</li><li>• Maintains volunteer appointment database.</li><li>• Coordinates annual appointments meetings and provides status updates and annual report of all volunteer appointments to the Mayor and Council.</li><li>• Processes all administrative paperwork associated with appointment of volunteers.</li><li>• Provide guidance regarding volunteer role and responsibilities.</li><li>• Assists in scheduling of committee meetings.</li><li>• Provides onboarding/orientation to newly appointed volunteers.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Appointed members should welcome citizen input at meetings and provide a channel for citizen expression by listening to comments, opinions, and concerns from the public.</li><li>• Each board is assigned a Council Liaison. The Council Liaison acts as the conduit between the board and governing body.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Primary responsibility is to advise and make recommendations to the Common Council when solicited.</li><li>• Each board serves as a link between the Common Council and the public, helping to inform the public of the board’s mission.</li></ul>
