# Design Creation

**June 2022** - Suburban Consulting Engineers delivers Playground Assessment and Recommendations to City of Summit with 1.3 million dollar recommendation for Tatlock.

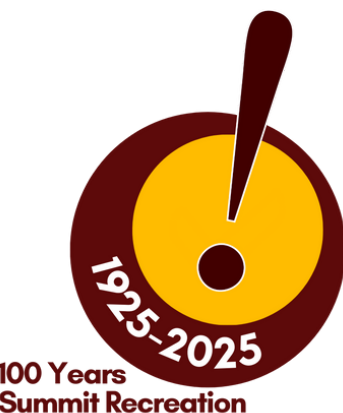
- *Decided theme for the Tatlock playground decided to be “nature”*

**Spring 2024** - Worked with Summit Public Schools IDEAS classes on design concepts.

**Fall 2024** - Survey sent out via DCP communication outlets and in a Washington School PTO newsletter to solicit feedback on the choices of the ideas classes.

**November-December 2024** - Meeting with playground providers to gain information.

**January 2025** - Cost estimates and renderings requested from Kompan.



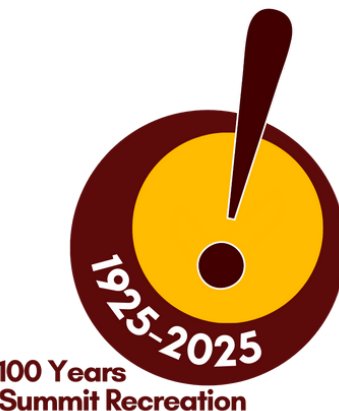
# Questions Raised

## School Playgrounds vs. City of Summit Playgrounds

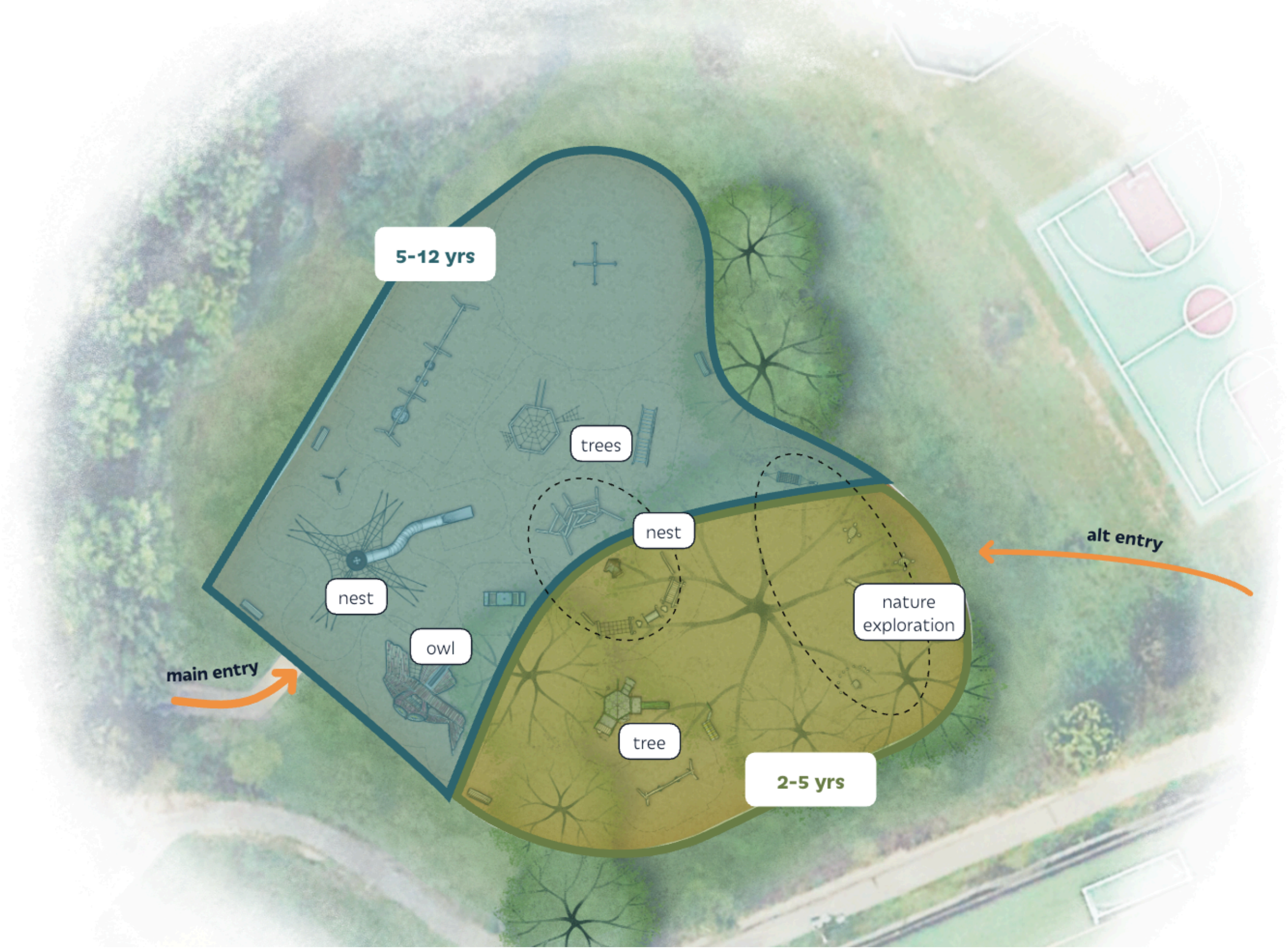
- Playgrounds at Mabie, Tatlock (with the exception of approximately 20% of the land), Memorial (behind Cornog Field House), and Wilson are all City of Summit Owned Playgrounds.
- Jefferson (being renovated FY 25), Brayton Blacktop (potentially being renovated FY 26), Franklin, and Lincoln Playgrounds are all owned by the Board of Education.

## Purchasing Mechanism

- Kompan playground equipment itself is on the State Contract.
- Kompan works with an installer which will allow for the playground to be installed on the Bergen County Co-op.

Option A: \$1,315,295.65

Option B: \$1,043,294.55

- Replace Owl's Nest with Climber with Smaller Tree Net
- Remove ground level nest climbers, balance trail and egg

\$500,000 - 2025 Capital Budget Request (Pending)

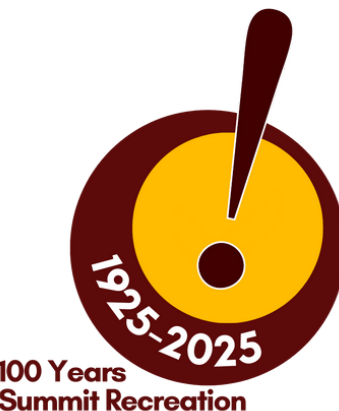

# Playground Timeline

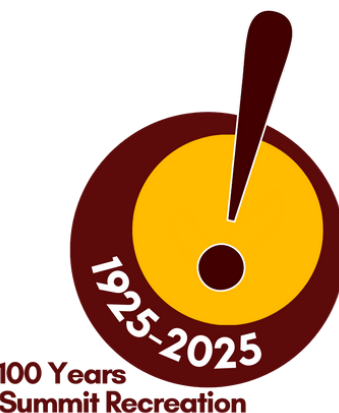
**March-July 2025:** Fundraising Campaign for Playground.

**May 2025\*:** Contract for the purchase of the Owl and Tree Play structures (these require specialized design, and a contract would need to be signed at this point to guarantee install by end of 2025).

- For these items there is a seven month lead time required

**September 2025:** Finalize full contract for purchase of all play equipment and install costs.

**November-December 2025\*:** Playground Construction.
