## CONTACT TRACING RESULTS

- 88 cases without available information;
- 64 cases report no known exposure;
- 34 cases unable to contact;
- 32 cases with positive household contacts;
- 19 cases with a known exposure;
  - Four cases exposed at work;
- Six cases refused to be interviewed;
- Three cases were hospitalized (ages 65, 54 and 21);
- Five cases associated with long-term care or congregate living;
- Six cases associated with travel; and
- Two fatalities, both were hospitalized. A 58-year-old Hispanic female and a 61-year-old Hispanic female.

- 48 cases ages 18 and younger;
- 37 cases ages 19 to 24;
- 15 cases ages 25 to 29;
- 13 cases ages 30 to 34;
- 18 cases ages 35 to 39;
- 16 cases ages 40 to 44;
- 18 cases ages 45 to 49;
- 23 cases ages 50 to 54;
- 21 cases ages 55 to 59;
- 24 cases ages 60 to 64;
- Nine cases ages 65 to 69;
- Nine cases ages 70 to 74;
- Four cases ages 75 to 79;
- Two cases ages 80 to 84;
- Three cases ages 85 to 89;
- Two cases ages 90 to 94;
- One case age 95 to 99.
