## **The Story of the 9/11 Memorial Trees Thursday 9/9**

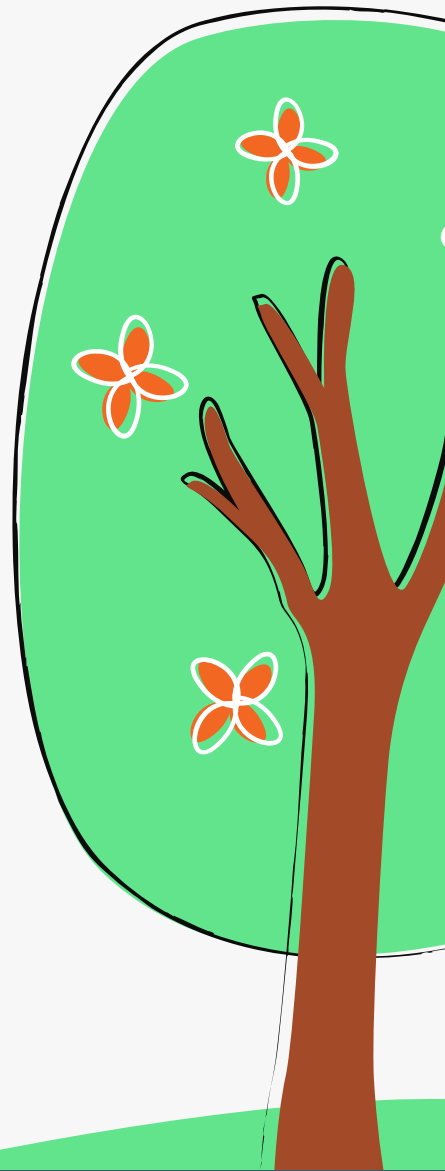
