Preview of Tuesday, October 5 Common Council meeting agenda by Council President Marjorie Fox

The next Common Council meeting will be held on Tuesday, October 5 at 7:30PM. Members of the public will be able to attend the meeting in person. Masks are required in City Hall and in Council Chamber. Extra seating will be available in the lobby to allow for social distancing.

Members of the public may comment by email to cityclerk@cityofsummit.org. Comments must be received by noon on October 5. Those who submit written comments will have their comment read by the clerk or summarized if substantially like other comments and will not be permitted to speak on that same subject at the meeting. The rules for public comments are posted on the city website. Every Common Council meeting is broadcast live on the City of Summit [YouTube Channel](#) and on HTTV Verizon channel 30 and Comcast channel 36 and 34.

First, the mayor will issue a proclamation recognizing Fire Prevention Week.

The Finance Committee will introduce a resolution to authorize the issuance of a note to finance Summit's share of the Joint Meeting Phase II Flood Mitigation Facilities Project. The Joint Meeting of Essex and Union Counties is made up of 11 member municipalities that operate a wastewater treatment facility. After Hurricane Sandy, the Joint Meeting began a multi-year flood mitigation project. In June 2020, council approved a bond ordinance for \$2,375,000 for Summit's share of Phase I and Phase II of the project. This resolution concerns the issuance of a note for Phase II to the Water Bank Construction Financing Program of the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank (I-Bank) in the amount of \$585K. Phase II is to upgrade the co-generation facilities and 90% of this funding will be reimbursed by FEMA.

The Capital Projects and Community Services Committee will introduce two resolutions. The first resolution authorizes the online auction of unneeded city vehicles and equipment through the state contract with Municibid. There is no cost to participate in the online auction. The second resolution is to declare two vacancies in the Division of Public Works.
