### **Annual Toys for Tots Holiday Toy Drive November 22 through December 13**

SUMMIT, NJ, November 8, 2021 – The Summit Policemen’s Benevolent Association #55 (PBA) and Firefighters Mutual Benevolent Association #54 (FMBA) are hosting the annual United States Marine Corps Reserve *Toys for Tots* holiday toy drive beginning Monday, November 22 through Monday, December 13.

To participate, bring new and unwrapped toys to the donation boxes at the following Summit locations during normal business hours between November 22 and December 13:

The PBA and FMBA will drop off donated toys to the Marine Corps Reserve on December 14.
