Preview of May 3 Common Council meeting agenda by Council President Marjorie Fox

The next Common Council meeting will be held on Tuesday, May 3 at 7:30PM in Council Chamber at City Hall.

Council will hold two budget hearings:

- The first hearing is on the 2022 municipal, parking utility, and sewer utility budgets. The 2022 municipal budget is a 1.98% increase over last year's municipal budget. The tax bill including the municipal, library, school, and county budgets, will show an increase of \$140.56 for the average assessed home in Summit (\$425,988).
- Council will hold a hearing and vote on the 2022 Special Improvement District budget. This is the budget for Summit Downtown, Inc., which is funded in part by a tax on businesses in the downtown business district.

Council will hold a hearing and vote on an ordinance to allow for the temporary closure of Maple Street.

- Council will hold a hearing on an ordinance to allow for the temporary closure of the street as a pedestrian mall.

Council will consider two Community Programs and Parking Services resolutions. The first will authorize the Summit Lacrosse Club to construct a gazebo and lacrosse wall at Tatlock Sports Complex and the second will confirm an appointment to the Community Programs Advisory Board by Mayor Radest.

Finally, council will hear five Capital Projects and Community Services Committee resolutions.

- Two resolutions will award bids for the Tulip Street Improvement and the Park Avenue Improvement projects.
- Two resolutions will authorize temporary parklets for outdoor dining for Pizza Vita on Union Place and Serra Restaurant on Bank Street.
- The final resolution will extend the city's participation in the state contract for online auction services with Municibid. This service allows the city to dispose of unneeded city property.

Duplicative or substantially similar comments may be summarized by the clerk and the clerk will stop reading emailed comments after three minutes.
