## **Preview of October 6 Common Council meeting agenda by Council President Marjorie Fox**

The next Common Council meeting will be held on Thursday, October 6 at 7:30PM in Council Chamber at City Hall.

Council will vote on a resolution to appoint five residents to the Broad Street West Financial Advisory Committee. The committee will work with redevelopment professionals to assist the city in reviewing and evaluating financial information pertaining to the proposed redevelopment project. This committee is the first step to engage members of the public in the redevelopment process. Further plans to include the public will be addressed at future council meetings.

The Finance Committee will introduce a resolution to fund an upgrade and replacement of audio/visual broadcasting equipment for the Council Chamber. This work will be completed as soon as equipment become available, most likely towards the end of this calendar year, and will improve the reliability and quality of the broadcast. It is a necessary step toward hybrid meeting capability if the state legislature provides procedural protections in the event of an equipment failure.

Finally, the Safety and Health Committee will introduce a resolution to authorize submission of a grant to help fund enhancements to the city's automated license plate reader system (ALPR). If awarded, this grant would assist in offsetting costs to upgrade the city's existing ALPR system to the latest technology and add additional readers. An enhanced ALPR system will allow the police to better monitor the movement of stolen vehicles in and out of Summit. It would also aid the police in responding to Amber and Silver alerts.
