Curriculum

Modeled after actual police academy curriculum, the program provides an opportunity for young people aged 11 to 14 to develop an understanding of the role of the police officer in the community.



Physical Training

Cadets undergo physical training, drill and ceremony training, instruction in criminal investigation techniques, and evidence recovery and patrol practices.



Demonstrations

Cadets visit the Union County Police Academy and attend demonstrations from the Union County Sheriff's K-9 unit, Union County SWAT team and bomb squad.



Program Admission

Admission to the program is on a rolling basis, with preference given to Summit residents who are first-time applicants; former recruits and out-of-town applicants may be placed on a waiting list. The tuition fee is \$125. A limited number of scholarships are available to those needing financial assistance.
